



CCCB National Reconciliation Fund Website Launched — On October 17, 2022, the national Indigenous

Reconciliation Fund implemented by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB), launched its website. The site can be viewed in English (https:// www.irfund.ca/). This national fund is the \$30 million pledge (over five years) that the Canadian Bishops made in September of 2021. The fund will be accessible to First Nation, Métis, and Inuit communities across this land for programs and initiatives that promote healing and reconciliation. Locally, the Archdiocese of Halifax-Yarmouth made a commitment to contribute over \$650,000 to this fund. Mi'kmag communities in the diocese will be able to apply for funding from this national fund for local projects that will promote healing and reconciliation. The website will be updated regularly and developed further as the Reconciliation Fund grows and evolves. The website can be accessed via the links above and by visiting www.cccb.ca. Please note that that this national fund is separate from the diocesan Reconciliation Fund collection that was held for the first time in June 2022.
