This past week, many of our parishioners and many from our Archdiocese participated in the Eucharistic Congress for which we, as a Church, have for some time been preparing, On Wednesday, I was delighted to be in attendance at the Cathedral for the reception of the Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Blessed Carlo will be canonized a Saint in 2025. This young man's life has impacted many - in his own family and among his friends. This young person's life was spent striving to bring people closer to Jesus – uniting them to Christ. 
