CHRISTMAS MASS SCHEDULE

Tuesday, December 24 7 pm at St. Bernard and 7 pm at St. Rose of Lima Wednesday, December 25 9 am at Holy Cross and 10 am at St. Rose of Lima

The third Advent candle, often called the Shepherds' candle, will be lit today signifying the joyful hope of God's people waiting for their Messiah. This Third Sunday of Advent is also called Gaudete Sunday. It is a Latin word meaning Rejoice! Modeling Mary, let us rejoice in our longing and waiting in the shadows of Advent for Christ. As Mary was filled with joy because God called her to be the Mother of the Messiah, we should remember that we too are called to share our gifts and serve with anticipatory joy all of His people.

4-Day Pilgrimage to Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré and Saint Joseph's Oratory in June 2025 — The dates will be June 4 to 7, 2025 inclusive. Day 1 we will drive to Quebec City and stay the night.
