# SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **JANUARY 15, 2023**

**Entering a New Season in Our Church Year** – We return in the Church's liturgical season to what we call Ordinary Time. The proclamation of Jesus Christ and the Paschal Mystery (His Life/ Death/Resurrection) continues to be the pivotal reality by which we continue to strive to live our every day – as ordinary and mundane or as much of a roller-coaster ride as it may be!

Our focus as Christian pilgrims walking the earth is to proclaim and give the gifts of His mercy and His love, which He gave to us. Weekday Mass Schedule — Throughout the winter months, we will continue to gather for Masses as scheduled. As we have to arrange funeral services/Masses and other significant special Masses, the schedule will have to be changed from time to time. We will communicate through use of our website to keep you informed. During the week, when a funeral is celebrated in any of our Churches, that day's scheduled Mass will be cancelled. Please feel welcome to come to the funeral Mass and support the grieving family by praying with them and for the repose of the soul of the faithful departed. If we know of any changes on the previous weekend, we will also try to announce them at all our Sunday Masses.



### Weekday Masses during the winter months....

**St. Bernard Church** – Tuesday evening 6:30 pm Mass and 9:00 am Thursday morning Mass will be celebrated in the Fr. Granville S.J. Room in the basement of the residence. The exception of course will be funerals and special Feast Day Masses.

**St. Rose of Lima Church** – Weekday Masses (Wednesday at 6:30 pm and Friday at 9:00 am) will continue to be celebrated in the main Church. **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** after Mass on Fridays will be moved to the little Chapel in back of the Sanctuary.

Requesting Special Masses — As most of you know, we have a tradition in our Church of offering Masses for the intentions given. Some request Mass to be said for the living — people who are alive but may be sick and for those celebrating wedding anniversaries or other significant occasions. Some request Mass offerings for those who have died, to have a mass celebrated for their soul. Some people request a Mass on an anniversary of death and ask for specific dates so that family may attend. We will strive to do the best we can to accommodate any of these requests or to be as close to the date requested. The stipend requested for any Mass offered is \$10.00. When the Mass is celebrated, the \$10.00 stipend goes to the priest. If there is more than one intention for any given Mass, the priest receives only one stipend and the other goes to the Parish.

Mass Offerings for the Living or Dead — Right now, Mass Cards can be obtained from each of the Parish Offices. A receipt is given to the person who requests the Mass offering, and a written log of requests is kept. Masses will be said by Father Gerald or a visiting priest. When we reach a large amount of Mass intentions, some will be given to retired priests who do not have a parish but celebrate Mass regularly. This is mainly to ensure that the Masses are celebrated in a timely manner. In the future, we hope to have Mass Cards available at the Churches, with someone designated to take care of the necessary paperwork. We look to do this for your convenience, in particular for those who may not be able to get to the Parish Office during the week.

Altar Servers for Sunday Masses — There have been a few young people come forward to assist in this ministry. It would be great to have a minimum of three servers for each Mass (more is welcome also). I would like those who have come forward to join others who are serving right now for training. There are also a couple of people who have agreed to assist in the coordination of the Altar Servers at St. Bernard and St. Rose of Lima. These people will soon be in touch with any young person who signed up to organize training and a schedule.

**Adult Servers** — If you are interested in assisting as a server at weekday Masses and at funeral Masses/services, please call one of the Church offices and leave your name, phone number and email so we can begin to organize and train.

A donation of **Christmas flowers** was made at Holy Cross in memory of loved ones **Eleanor and Bob Killen**. Their names were mistakenly left off the list distributed with the Christmas bulletin. May they rest in peace.
