24th Sunday of Ordinary Time – September 15, 2024

This Sunday we reflect with a conversation Jesus has with his disciples. "Who do people say that I am?" Jesus is asking the Disciples about the word on the street. The people see and experience his works and actions in people's lives, and they react to what they see and try and put a name on him. This is what the disciples tell Jesus. The more pressing question comes when Jesus asks the disciples directly, "But who do you say that I am?" This is more personal, and the answer that the disciples give would have been based upon what they have learned about Christ but also how seriously they have entered into the relationship with Christ after hearing the initial call – "Come follow me." The disciples' response to Jesus would indicate how the disciples' minds and hearts have been transformed in the presence of Christ. The answer the disciples would give demonstrates a great mystery of the relationship they still do not fully understand but are truly beginning to grasp. What does it mean for you and me in this present age to be a true follower of Christ? How do we accept the crosses that come as a result of following Christ? What does it mean for you to lose your life and yet have it saved in Christ? As we ponder these questions, we need to also acknowledge that Jesus Christ indeed wants our relationship with him to grow ... Jesus wants us to trust him ... Is there anything that we need to let go of in order for that to truly happen? Is there any fear or relationship that is a stumbling


